

# PTC Meeting

## March 8, 2016

### Call to Order:

- Karen Kuniyoshi, PTC President called the meeting to order at 7:08 pm in the Maple Creek LMC.

### Principal's Report

- Gold Ribbon visitation was on Monday – Visitation went well, yes was checked, now forwarded on to state superintendent
- Civic Learning Award – we applied and got honored with Merit level.
- Cheer took first place in their division. (cheer program was source of complaints on SART surveys 3 years ago, program was looked at and is better now)
- Robotics – Teams did great, one team took home a teamwork award.
- Update on solar structure: putting it over both play structures – not approved yet, will get voted on in April.

### New Requests:

- Mr. Parker – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade: Time for Kids – requesting for next year 468.00 (does not include tax/shipping) Request is for just over \$500 – for 105 students. Using grade level allotment for this purchase. Motion to approve, motion seconded, motion carries.
- Mr. Parker – softball team – pitching machine used to practice batting on higher speed hitting and practicing fly balls. There is a wheel that is not easily balanced, it was fixed last summer (wheel came off and had to be reinflated and now it is no longer balanced so need a new wheel) but it is still not working. Request for \$150 to replace wheel of pitching machine. Motion to approve, motion seconded . Motion carries.
- Donna Sibley – One of our 6<sup>th</sup> graders was diagnosed with Leukemia. Staff and class have done great things for him. Donna would like permission to put a money tree up at Toasting Twenty years – separate from silent auction so that people who would want to could donate for their expenses. Is it ok to do this at the Toasting Twenty Years event? What is going to make more money? Gina said it was possible to do a meal night/event in May. Possible Bunko night, Bingo, or meal night. Is it ok to wait until May? It was agreed that it is probably better for an event focused on that instead of at parent night. Donna is withdrawing her request so that an event can be planned. Bingo night seems like a good idea. Meet before next meeting to have ideas ready.
