Call to Order:

Principal's Report

- Open house will be April 27th – can PTC have food; shave ice, etc. Yes, we will do that again this year.
- Jerry is officially retired; Mrs. Woo and Mr. Parker are retiring as well. Ray is filling in, Jerry's position is not filled yet. They interviewing now.
- Tables PTC purchases are now put together. Ray is going to get an ETA on when they will be installed. (has to go through a work order with the district, that is the delay)
- LCAP (Local Control Accountability Funding) is an action plan targeting low income and English language learners. Shoua Yang is on campus working with 5th and 6th graders. This will also possibly fund a psychologist for area schools to deal with social emotional issues.
- State testing is around the corner (begins first week of May). CASP – ELA testing is going to be broken into 2 sections. Trying to set it up better so that kids do not get tired/burned out, etc.
