Some feedback- Food Crowded, Move cake walk in front of MPR where the cakes were located, Allow Autistic children in ½ hour early, push back 1 week because of weather, Friday vs Saturday, The carnival was during the Fresno Fair & Football season. Football schedules for High School will not come out before date needs to be set with CUSD for Carnival. Early Estimate of Earnings ~\$11,000. Next years festival will start planning May 2018.
